Marble Arch Place is a 40,000-square-meter (430,550-square-foot) mixed-use, two building development with residential, office, retail, restaurants, and cinema that marks the western end of Oxford Street, London's famous shopping street. Located immediately north of the Grade I-listed Marble Arch and Portman Estate Conservation Area, the project responds in scale and mass to the surrounding urban context, serving as a backdrop to the arch itself. By separating the residential from the office on a trapezoidal site, the design varies the street wall to complement neighboring structures, emphasizes the corner where two heavily trafficked roads meet, and extends the commercial nature of Oxford Street with a pedestrian retail thoroughfare.
