The Gabrielle H. Reem and Herbert J. Kayden Center for Science and Computation highlights Bard College's increased commitment to the integration of the sciences into its liberal arts curriculum. The 6,410-square-meter (69,000-square-foot) building provides space for the biology, chemistry, computer science, and mathematics departments in a facility equipped with state-of-the-art

teaching and research laboratories, high-tech classrooms, and a 60-person auditorium. Constructed in a prominent, central campus location, the design solution for this program paid close attention to site planning, as well as, spatial composition to encourage student-faculty interaction in informal spaces.
